

Shop To Let

Tunbridge Wells 40-42 Calverley Road

Location

The subject property, formerly Hotter Shoes, is located in a prime trading position on Calverley Road, neighbouring Waterstones and Clarks, opposite the Calverley Road entrance to the Royal Victoria Place Shopping Centre.

A 5 minute walk to Tunbridge Wells train station, the vacant unit is surrounded by multiple national occupiers such as Holland & Barrett, Costa, M&S, Barclays, EE, Pret A Manger and Lush to name a few.
